

Installing VMware View Icon Instructions


This is instructions for how to load the VMware View icon on your desktop. Using this icon will allow you to access the virtual desktop.

Before starting this process, save any documents you are currently working on. You will reboot your computer at the end of this process.


Follow the step-by-step instructions to get the icon.

Use Internet Explorer as your browser.

Step 1: Using Internet Explorer: Go to <https://sec2.dhhs.state.nc.us>; You will see a page that looks like the one below. Choose **“Continue to this website (not recommended)”**




You will then see a screen that looks like the one below. Click on **“View Client for Windows.”**



You will then see a screen that looks like the one below.

- First Choose “2.0”
- Next choose “Go to Downloads” under” VMWare View Clients for 32-Bit Windows”




You will then see a Screen that looks like the one below.

- First Choose “2.3.0”
- Next Choose “Download.”



You will then see a page that looks like the one below.

- Choose “Run.”




It will then begin the download. This will take a couple of minutes.

You will now start to install the VMWare.

There will be a number of screens. We will be accepting the “default” on all these screens so we will just have to accept everything. Below are all the screens in order. You will need to choose “Next.” on all of them.


Screen 1: Choose “Next.”




Screen 2: Choose "Accept" then "Next."




Screen 3: Choose "Next."




Screen 4: Choose "Next."




Screen 5: Choose "Next."




Screen 6: Choose "Next."



Screen 7: Choose "Install"




It will begin installing. This will take a few minutes.
You will see a screen that looks like the one below.



You will then see a screen that looks like the one below.

- Choose **“Finish.”**



You will then see a screen that asks you to restart your computer.

- Choose **“Yes”**

When the computer comes back online you will have a virtual icon.
