SpringShire seeks approval for 20-bed nursing facility in Greenville

RALEIGH – SpringShire Retirement Community has filed a Certificate of Need application with the N.C. Department of Health and Human Services to develop a 20-bed facility with 12 nursing care beds and 8 adult care home beds as part of a new continuing care retirement community (CCRC) to be developed in Greenville.

The CCRC will be comprised of 162 independent living units, including 150 apartments and 12 cottages. This nursing facility project is expected to cost \$6.4 million and to be completed in December 2018.

A public hearing for this project will be held Aug. 19 at 11 a.m. in the Eugene James Auditorium on the 2nd Floor of the Pitt County Administrative Office Building, 1717 West 5th St., Greenville.

Anyone may file written comments concerning this proposal. Comments must be received by the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section no later than 5:30 p.m. on Aug. 1.
