Novant seeks approval for rehabilitation facility in Winston-Salem

RALEIGH – Novant Health Rehabilitation Hospital of Winston-Salem has filed a Certificate of Need application with the N.C. Department of Health and Human Services to relocate 68 inpatient rehabilitation beds from Novant Health Forsyth Medical Center to a new rehabilitation facility to be developed on Hillcrest Center Drive in Winston-Salem.

A public hearing for this project will be held September 19, 2016 at 11 a.m. in the Novant Health Conference Center, Charter Hall, on the first floor of Novant Health Forsyth Medical Center located at 3333 Silas Creek Parkway in Winston Salem.

This project is expected to cost \$28.3 million and to be completed in January 2019.

Anyone may file written comments concerning this proposal. Comments must be received by the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section no later than 5:30 p.m. on Aug. 31.
