Carolinas Medical Center seeks approval to acquire an intraoperative MRI

RALEIGH – The Charlotte-Mecklenburg Hospital Authority d/b/a Carolinas Medical Center has filed a Certificate of Need application with the N.C. Department of Health and Human Services to develop an intraoperative magnetic resonance scanner.

A public hearing for this project will be held Sept. 20 at 11:30 a.m. in Conference Room 270, Charlotte-Mecklenburg Government Center, 600 E. 4th St., Charlotte.

The project is expected to cost \$13.1 million and to be complete in Jan. 2018. The MRI is supposed to be developed in a renovated operating room at Carolinas Medical Center
