**SPA# 12-013 (PCS)** - The purpose of this state plan change is to add the reference to 42 CFR 440.110 in the Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnosis and Treatment (EPSDT) hearing aid services section of the State Plan. This amendment is in accordance with the CMS companion letter sent with the State Plan Amendment approval of SPA 11-033. CMS instructed the State to add specific language or provide an assurance in the State plan that all audiology services meet the requirements of 440.110.

**SPA# 12-018 (Pharmacy Dispensing Fees)** - To implement the requirements of Session Law 2012-142, Section 10.8(a1), the Division of Medical Assistance is submitting a State Plan Amendment to modify the dispensing fees to achieve savings outlined in the legislation. This State Plan will revise the dispensing fee for brands to \$3.00 and the generic dispensing fee structure will be one of 4 rate tiers which will be based upon previous quarterly generic volume of generic dispensing rates
