

It's simple math...



***Over six years of program participation**

The first year payment amount is \$21,250. If you typically net \$50/office visit, you would need to see **425 patients** to get the same amount of money.

Ask yourself two questions:

1. Do you see 30% Medicaid patients?
2. Do you use certified EHR technology?

Yes? If you are a physician, dentist, nurse practitioner, certified nurse midwife, or a physician assistant practicing in a PA-led FQHC/RHC then you may be eligible to participate in the NC Medicaid EHR Incentive Program.

Medicaid volume not 30%? Pediatricians can qualify with 20% patient volume. Do you work in an FQHC/RHC? You can count needy individuals (no pay, sliding scale, Health Choice, etc.) toward your Medicaid patient volume to be eligible for the EHR Incentive Program.

If you use certified EHR technology but do not meet the Medicaid requirements, you may still be eligible for incentive payments from Medicare. Find out more at the CMS website: <https://ehrincentives.cms.gov>.
