The following Disqualified Individual _____ :

- ___ voluntarily and without good cause quit a job of at least thirty (30) hours per week (or 30 hours multiplied by minimum wage). The individual must serve only the mandatory disqualification period. The disqualification ends if the individual becomes exempt from work requirements.
- ___ reduced working hours to less than thirty (30) hours per week (or 30 hours multiplied by minimum wage). The individual must serve only the mandatory disqualification period. The disqualification ends if the individual becomes exempt from work requirements.

After serving the appropriate disqualification period for voluntary quit or reduction of work hours, the person will be added back to the Food and Nutrition Services (FNS) benefits. If you are no longer receiving FNS benefits, you would need to reapply.

- ___ failed to comply with Unemployment Insurance Benefits (UIB) work requirements. The person must become exempt from work requirements (for reasons other than receipt of UIB or participation in Work First Family Assistance (WFFA) Employment Services) or comply with UIB work requirements.
- ___ failed to comply with Work First Family Assistance (WFFA) Employment Services. The person must become exempt from work requirements (for reasons other than receipt of Unemployment Insurance Benefits (UIB) or participation in WFFA Employment Services) or comply with WFFA Employment Services.
