

Reduction Factors for Calculating Medicaid Eligibility Under the Pickle Amendment During 2010

If the last month in which a person received SSI while, or immediately prior to, receiving Social Security was in any of the periods below, multiply the present amount of his Social Security by the corresponding factor to obtain the current countable COLA Passalong income:
