

**Arrival-Departure Record, Form I-94:** The Form I-94 is issued by INS to nonimmigrants and attached to an unexpired foreign passport. Each Form I-94 has an 11-digit admission number in the upper left corner on the back of the arrival and departure sections of the form. It does not contain a photograph, and sometimes also indicates an A-Number, but not always. This document may bear one of the following annotations:

- Section 207 - Refugee
- Section 208 - Asylee
- Section 212(d)(5) - Parolee
- Section 243 (h)
- Cuban-Haitian Entrant
- Employment Authorized

The Form I-94 contains an expiration date.
